

Wedmore Village Hall Access Statement – reviewed 25/5/22

We aim to provide a first class visitor experience to all visitors and user groups and are continuously looking to improve accessibility and facilities.

Access to the Hall

- All rooms are available to hire every day of the week. The booking calendar is kept updated on the web site www.wedmorehall.org.uk where there is also an on-line booking form.
- A key to access the Hall is kept in a key safe located beside the Hall rear entrance.

Arrival & Car Parking Facilities

- The Hall is located in Cheddar Road, post code BS28 4EQ, and has a pedestrian and vehicle access which is flat and even. The What3words address is ///drones.legend.scratches
- Vehicular entrance into the car park is off Manor Lane. There is one disabled car space available, located at the point in the car park that is closest to the Hall entrance.
- There are eleven other parking spaces available to Hall users. Other vehicles may use the free Wedmore Village car park which is clearly signposted from Cheddar Road.

Public Areas – General

- The main hall can be accessed via a gently sloping ramp, with handrail, that leads to the rear of the main hall. There is level access to this ramp from the car park.
- Within Wedmore Village Hall all rooms have a level access through doorways of at least 80 cm width.
- All areas of Wedmore Village Hall are non-smoking areas.

Public Areas – Toilets

- There is one toilet within the Hall for the use of disabled people. Access is level.
- This toilet is unisex and there is no need for a key.
- The door opens inwards and locks by a twist lock.

Public Areas – Kitchen

- There is a gas cooker, commercial dishwasher and fridge/freezer available to all users.
- The worktops are at a height where wheelchair users may have some difficulties.

Hearing Assistance

- The Hall has an induction loop installed. It is the responsibility of Hall users who wish to take advantage of the loop to use suitable microphones at their event to feed the loop system. The Hall has microphones and a public address system for this purpose.
